Proposed reporting and regulation of PFAS

Dear Customer,

We can conclude the survey of our suppliers as follows:

The EU intends to comprehensively restrict PFAS substances. All details about the current proposal, the consultation phase that has been running since March 22nd 2023, as well as the associated implementation periods can be found under these links:

The current proposal provides for a complete ban on all PFAS (with a few exceptions) 18 months after entry into force (end of 2025 at the earliest). For specific uses, transitional periods are allowed until about 2032 or 2038. Currently, there is no definitive decision by ECHA. It remains to be seen whether industry objections will result in a subdivision of PFAS. We will be informed by suppliers well in advance and will pass this information to your organization.

The affected components purchased by your organization from NTI are primarily the plain bearings installed in the motors. In addition, there are other discrete vendor parts that are in the responsibility of the suppliers.

We are already investing extensive R&D resources together with our suppliers to look for potential alternative materials and components.
